Kia ora anō

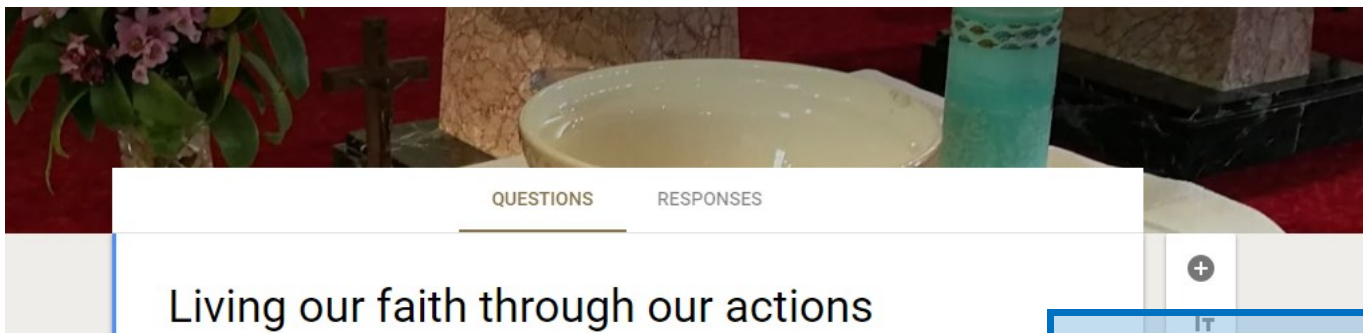

## Changes to bus routes affecting St Anne's

### 145 Westmorland – Eastgate and 535 Eastgate – Lyttelton & Rapaki

From Monday 29<sup>th</sup> October the 145 Westmorland – Eastgate and 535 Eastgate – Lyttelton & Rapaki bus routes that some students may be using to travel to and from school will no longer operate.

Instead they will be replaced by the 155 Lyttelton – Eastgate shopper service. The new 155 service will begin operating on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> October.

Students and parents need to be aware so no students are unable to coordinate alternative travel to and from school on Monday.
